**\* Membership Types**

Brand-new fencers, those taking the Intro to Fencing class, are only eligible to sign up as Regular members. Once they complete the course, they are able to sign up as Competition Fencers in their second trimester. Please speak to the club President if you wish to sign up as a Competition Fencer sooner.

Competition Fencers will select a *primary* weapon at the beginning of the trimester and will focus on that weapon when they come on Mondays. Fencers who are focusing on sabre or epee should also plan to attend on Tuesdays, foil fencers should come on Thursdays because the Floor Leader will be available to fence and leading drills for those specific weapons on those particular nights. However, foil fencers are certainly welcome and encouraged to come on Tuesdays, same for sabre or epee fencers on Thursdays! After 8:00 PM on Tuesday and Thursday, Competition Fencers will be allowed to switch to another weapon. Competition Fencers who do not meet the expectations listed above may be subject to disciplinary measures or become ineligible to join the SCFC as a Competition Fencer in the future. Please direct questions or concerns to the Head Coach.

**\*\* Voting Eligibility**

To be eligible to vote at a club election, a person must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Be a current member of the Summit City Fencing Club
2. Be at least 14 years of age
3. Be self-designated as a voting member on their membership form. (If you choose this option, your attendance may be necessary to achieve quorum and you will be expected to attend the club meetings when they are held.)
4. Have been a member of the club for a full trimester (a four-month period) during the previous two years (within the last six trimesters).

High School/College Introduction to Fencing (ages 13-22) Adult Intro to Fencing (ages 18 and up)	8	\$36	\$72	Assumes the participant has <u>no</u> knowledge of fencing. Introduces footwork, how to hold blade, parry/riposte, etc. Will focus on foil, but will show epee and sabre to acquaint new members with other weapons. Syllabus is geared towards preparing fencers for "Basics" level.
Epee Basics Foil Basics Sabre Basics	8	\$30	\$65	Assumes the participant has basic knowledge of fencing, each class focuses on a particular weapon. Will review footwork, parry/riposte, etc. Add to knowledge of weapon and sport in increasing measure. Geared towards those who have completed "Intro" course or who are returning to sport after hiatus. Mostly non-electric, some electric towards end. <i>(All Basics classes ages 10 and up)</i>
